Sister Jeanne Bartholomeaux



"I'm passionate about teaching," says Sister Jeanne Bartholomeaux, theology teacher at Salpointe High School in Tucson, Arizona. Sister Jeanne sees her job as much more than passing on the Catholic faith. "My philosophy of education is to open up a space in the minds and hearts of young persons to discover both themselves and God." Realizing the great

growth that occurs as students mature during their high school years, Sister Jeanne speaks: "I feel honored to companion young people on this journey."

She deliberately creates a learning environment that gives her students life skills: practical decision-making, service to others, reflective learning. This year, her freshman students at Salpointe will help inaugurate a new "impact program" in which they, accompanied by faculty mentors, will work for a full week to address homelessness, poverty, hunger and immigration issues. Hands-on service is coupled with reflection activities "to help us all integrate practical experience with Gospel values."



What would she like her students to remember? She says, "You're created in God's image—how do you reflect that?"

"I'm also passionate about art!" Sister Jeanne lights up. As a practicing and exhibiting fiber artist, whenever she has time she is creating pieces large and small with thick yarns woven into pieces large enough to decorate a wall in the Sky Harbor Airport Chapel in Phoenix or fine silk embroidery floss outlining an intricate design on delicate fabric. "I think about art as a way to talk to people through the creative process—to take people to places they can't reach in any other way." She characterizes her art as "change-scapes" or ways to open up minds, asking the viewer to confront what prevents them from changing. "It's an invitation; some accept it, but others back away and return to older ways.

Of her piece hanging at the airport, Sister Jeanne learned of a man who was on his way home to bury his wife and child who had been killed in an accident. He reported taking a copy of her meditation and the picture with him, peaceful and assured that he could go on to do what he had to do.

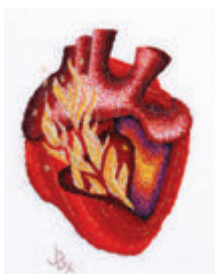
The tapestry was momentous for Sister herself. She had learned of her own mother's diagnosis of lung cancer and everything "turned upside down. I began to use darker colors and reversed the fabric in places, turning it inside out. I opened a crack in the middle of the piece, where light could come through and added strong images like roots." The whole work was one of contrasts: hope and fear, optimism and apprehension. But its message touched people beyond what even the weaver created. Said Sister Jeanne, "When I finish an artwork, I have no control over what it says. I hear from people that they discover things I did not intentionally put there—the art speaks for itself!"



Her own spirituality informs her latest series of embroideries on the heart "Hearts Marked by the Blood of the Lamb." She said the series is dedicated to all those enduring redemptive suffering. "It might be a person dealing with serious illness, mental or emotional problems, the loss of a loved one. It might speak to the letting go process for others." But the pieces are about survival of the spirit.

Her artistic bent revealed itself from Sister Jeanne's earliest years. In grade school and high school, she was involved in drawing and graphic design. She's also done sculptures, but it was in graduate school that she knew her medium was with fiber: weaving, felting, basket weaving. "Sometimes I add a few beads—they're seductive, you know."

Growing up in a family of six children, Sister Jeanne claims she is a native child of Arizona, even though her parents were Midwesterners. Her mother grew up in Kansas; she was educated by the Sisters of Charity of Leavenworth. Her father was from Iowa. She recalls a very close family for whom nature, camping and fishing, and the church were essentials. "My parents modeled faith and service. They had very little, but they were always

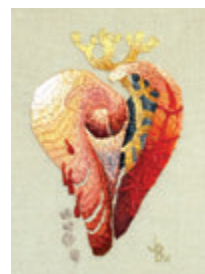

helping others." Educated at Saints Peter and Paul Elementary School and at Salpointe High School, she remembers how important the Seton Hill Sisters of Charity were to them as the family grew up. "They helped my mother raise her youngest brother, my uncle. Sisters Mary Inez, Mary Amy, Mary Timothy, Francis Mary and Theodosia were almost members of the family!"

It would seem that a vocation to the Sisters of Charity was a natural fit for young Jeanne.



She recalls the visit of a missionary who captured her third-grade heart with accounts of "making a difference." She knew that's what she wanted to do. "It was a toss-up—I was either going to be a nurse or a sister!" She made a bargain with God; if we were at war, I would be a nurse. If it was peacetime, I'd become a sister." Her attraction to the community came largely because the

sisters were so active and involved with the students. "I liked the spirit and the fact that they were there with and for the students in our campus life, not just in the classroom."

Later, she comments, "I realized how important the emphasis on the Eucharist was to me. The Sisters certainly modeled that, even as my father did. He went to daily mass after his retirement." This life has been a challenging and fulfilling one for Sister Jeanne. "I've had so many opportunities for growth, for developing my talents and self-confidence."

Earlier this year, Sister Jeanne assumed yet another role, that of Vicar for Religious in the Diocese of Tucson. In that position she supports and connects the approximately 200 religious sisters and brothers from close to 40 communities, who serve in the diocese. She has a representative committee which helps her plan diocesan jubilee celebrations, an annual convocation, a day of prayer, and a bi-annual art exhibit featuring the works of women and men religious. Photographers, sculptors, painters and iconographers display their works of fine art. Even Bishop Gerald Kicanas, who is a gifted photographer, shares images from his work around the globe with Catholic Relief Services.

She serves on the Bishop's staff, with regular meetings and consultation, especially in matters of vocation ministry. The diocesan office for vocations deals specifically with priesthood candidates, and Sister Jeanne coordinates efforts with other young persons discerning ministry in the church. She finds that "they want to know what God wants of them. It's not always directly about a

is about the quiet waiting in the dark for the light that marks the season of Advent balanced with the pure gift of new life that characterizes spring.

At the top of the tapestry the two pieces of teal and black fabric are two sides of the same fabric. It reflects the way life changes drastically when something critical and unexpected happens in life. Its captures the sensation that everything is turned upside down or inside out. There is a struggle that one faces when illness or death comes upon someone close and all life changes completely.

A pattern of roots remind that one responds in the present based on what has been experienced and learned in the past. These roots could be a conduit of nourishment or they could be a binding web. The brown limb across the bottom represents strength that can be relied on in the time of crisis. It has always been there before to support and will be there now.

The thin lines vibrating across the surface represent the universality of the experience of change. They are derived from an artist's interpretation of the Super String Theory of physics. Everything appears to be connected as energized strings. In this context, the presence of the strings relates to the fact that everything changes, sometimes with gentle transition and sometimes with harsh abruptness. It is the way of life.

The glowing light in the center is simply the light of hope. If one has hope then the darkness cannot overcome. The change cannot break us. One cannot remain in the dark. Life continues in the light.

Sister Jeanne's Green Bean Salad

*(Simple to make & good for pot lucks)
A recipe from my mother, Kitty Bartholomeaux,
with a couple of adjustments.*

Ingredients:

*Canned, Frozen, or (lightly steamed)
Fresh Green Beans*

- 1 small Onion*
- 3 or 4 Hard Boiled Eggs*

Dressing:

- Mayonnaise*
- Salt and Pepper*
- Dill Weed (my recommendation)*
- Prepared mustard (my addition)*

Preparation:

- 3 or 4 Hard boil Eggs.*

- Warm 1 or 2 cans of Green Beans just enough to be hot...drain You can use the equivalent Frozen Green Beans or lightly steamed fresh Green Beans)*
- Dice onion. Quantity to taste.*

religious vocation, but about their entire faith life. They want to be of service." Many vocation programs in the Tucson diocese are directed at minority youth. "There's an energy and enthusiasm in the Hispanic community. This is the field ripe with vocations in Tucson at this time."

Indeed, Sister Jeanne wears many hats. Her passions for art and education compete, but that's not all bad. "It's a challenge, but I wouldn't want to have to choose just one!" She has spent fourteen years as an art teacher and twelve as a theology teacher; in addition, she has taught in parochial schools and done religious education in parishes. She also served a six-year term on the General Council of the Sisters of Charity. Now she has a compact schedule at the high school which allows her to be in her diocesan office in the afternoons. How does she balance it all? "I just have to be present to what's before

me. And my annual retreat in the desert provides the time and space to rediscover priorities."

She credits her life in community for much of what keeps her going. "I know my elder sisters at Caritas Christi have prayed me through many a situation. And our local community is so supportive." (Sister Jeanne shares daily life with Sisters Claudia Rushlow and Maria Consuelo Pacheco at Sts. Peter and Paul Convent.) Whether it's a lengthy discussion of the day's activities at the dinner table or the "sacred time for evening prayer — we almost never miss that," Sister Jeanne counts on the richness of community to sustain her busy life.

Sister. Artist. Teacher. Vicar. Sister Jeanne Bartholomeaux could answer to all of these. But it is in the mix that this dedicated and talented Sister of Charity finds her everyday joy.

Assembly:

- put onions on bottom of bowl.*
- pour the hot beans on top.*
- This releases the flavor of the onions.*
- cut up the hard boiled eggs on top*
- toss with dressing*

Dressing:

- 2 tablespoons of mayonnaise, add 1/2 teaspoon of prepared mustard.*

*If you choose: add a couple drops of lemon juice to taste.
(Optional variation: Dice some celery and add for texture.)*

"I always remember Mom telling her daughters how to make perfect hard boiled eggs.

Bring the pan of water with the eggs in it to a boil. Boil for 5 minutes, cover the pan with a lid, and turn off the heat. Let sit for 15 minutes. Drain hot water and replace with cold so you can handle to peel."

A Milestone Anniversary Celebration of Years of Everyday Joys

In the tradition of the Catholic Church, the word “Jubilee” is used to designate an anniversary year. Special reverence is given to the 50th and 25th anniversaries of religious life—the Golden and Silver Jubilees.



Sister Brycelyn Eyler, Golden Jubilarian

As I reflect on my past years, I think of lyrics to a song I once knew, “. . . years of sunshine, days of rain.” Religious life entails many years of sunshine for me. The Sisters of Charity motto, “Humility, simplicity, charity, and remember that God is ever present,” inspires me daily to see God in every event and person in my life. I need only pay attention to God’s presence that permeates every moment. At the end of every day, I look over my day to find those God-moments in my life—the face of a child, an unexpected gift of a flower, laughter of my co-workers, kindness shown in varied ways. As Mother Seton once wrote, “Contemplate how you are being asked to give your heart to God amidst your everyday activities. Be prepared to meet your grace in every circumstance of life.” I pray that through the incarnational spirituality of the Sisters of Charity, I will recognize God’s presence in every event, action, and person of my day.

Sister Brycelyn’s call to religious life came through the Sisters of Charity who taught her in both grade school and high school. A Pittsburgh native, Sister Brycelyn entered the Sisters of Charity from Sacred Heart Parish, Shadyside, on September 8, 1963. She earned a bachelor’s degree in biology and elementary education from Seton Hill University, a master’s degree from Indiana University of Pennsylvania, and certification in administration from Loyola College, Maryland.

Now in her 50th year of religious life, Sister Brycelyn is serving her second term as Provincial Councilor/Vice President for the United States Province of the Sisters of Charity of Seton Hill, a position to which she was first elected in 2007. She is conference leader for the Caritas Christi Conference of the congregation and oversees buildings and grounds maintenance as well as technology operations for the Sisters of Charity. “I enjoy working with the sisters and our lay partners,” said Sister Brycelyn. She approaches the challenges of her responsibilities with a gracious ease and confidence in those with whom she works. During her first term in office, Sister Brycelyn was the Provincial Councilor for Ministry and Social Justice. In this role she was responsible for directing the sisters in their respective ministries.

Prior to being elected to the provincial council in 2007, Sister Brycelyn served as a pre-kindergarten through grade eight principal and middle school teacher for the Dioceses of Greensburg and Pittsburgh, and the



Archdiocese of Baltimore. In 1995, she was appointed the first principal of Aquinas Academy in Greensburg, a merger of four schools. Sister Brycelyn held that position for 12 years.

A strong advocate for social justice, Sister Brycelyn has an abiding concern for the poor and disenfranchised. In 2005, Sister Brycelyn was one of 120 Catholic educators from the United States who joined 18,000 people from around the world participating in the March of the Living, an event sponsored by the Anti-Defamation League. The march retraced the journey countless Jewish people made to the death camps more than 60 years earlier. Participants also visited the Jewish sections of Krakow, Poland and the Warsaw Ghetto. In reflecting on the experience, Sister Brycelyn said important bonds were formed. "We were really blessed to have this opportunity. I feel that I have to do more to see that this tragedy never happens again. We must emphasize the importance of doing the 'right thing.' We have to teach that."

Most of Sister Brycelyn's ministry as a woman religious has been in Catholic schools. "Even as a young child, I wanted to be a teacher," said Sister Brycelyn. As an educator, Sister Brycelyn used her gifts to embody the vision of Elizabeth Ann Seton. She sought to educate students to live the light of faith and infuse the world with moral values. As an administrator, she encouraged teachers to be examples of justice, believers in Catholic education and its mission, proclaimers of God's word, and lovers of God's children.

Sister Brycelyn sees herself as the one who reaped the rewards of her ministry in the everyday joys she experienced at school. She fondly recalls touching memories that include a big brother kissing his little sister goodbye each day as they got off the school bus and the love that parents and teachers demonstrated by preparing meals for a seriously ill mother of a young student. She describes the rewards of her education ministry by saying her work was "life-giving and instrumental in bringing me closer to God through students, faculty, staff, parents, and all who influenced and inspired me every day."

Sister Brycelyn's leadership roles within her community, her service as an educator, her advocacy for social justice issues, and her ministry to the poor and disenfranchised express the charism of the Sisters of Charity. She continually helps others "to meet their grace in every circumstance of life."

Sister Donna Mulligan, Silver Jubilarian

"The past 25 years as a Sister of Charity have presented me more joys, challenges, and discoveries than I could ever have imagined. It has truly been a privilege to share life with so many wonderful women as sisters and all



those I have come to know through my ministries. From the very beginning God confirmed my choice of religious life through my experiences in ministry. As part of my formation as a novice I participated in a Clinical Pastoral Education (CPE) unit at Westmoreland Hospital. My duties included visiting patients who had not listed a religious affiliation in their records. I discovered that several patients were Catholics who had been away from the church for quite a while

and were not sure God still loved them. One gentleman named Joe, whom I will never forget, told me it was over 40 years since he had been to church. He wanted to "get right with God." He asked me to help him. Through tears, he shared with me many of the ways he believed that he had let God and his family and friends down. As I prayed with him, I knew then that I was in the right place—that I could be God's instrument in helping others. I arranged for a priest to visit Joe and before he died the next week he was able to be at peace. Since then I have experienced over and over again how God uses simple events in daily life to bring about healing and forgiveness. I am always greatly humbled and overjoyed when I realize that God has worked through me in some way to accomplish a building up of his kingdom. Nothing gives me greater satisfaction or happiness!"

As a young adult, Sister Donna Mulligan saw a great need in the church and the world for the message of love that Christ proclaims in the Gospels. Interaction with many religious who were her teachers, relatives, and neighbors when she was growing up influenced Sister Donna's decision to enter the congregation on August 20, 1988, from Saint Nicholas Parish, Nicktown, Pennsylvania.

Now in her 25th year of religious life, Sister Donna is a pastoral associate for the Partner Parishes of Connellsville, Pennsylvania (Saint Rita, Saint John the Evangelist, and Immaculate Conception Parishes).

In her three-year ministry with the Catholic community of Connellsville, Sister Donna's responsibilities include faith formation programs, sacramental preparation, assistance with the Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults (RCIA) program, management of the partner parish website, oversight of the Junior Youth Ministry program, and the training of liturgical ministers. Sister Donna recognizes that many activities and events compete for the time and attention of families and young people, making it difficult to keep faith formation a family priority. She works diligently to help families overcome such obstacles and joyfully relates, "My ministry has provided countless opportunities to experience God at work in the lives of people of



all backgrounds. I have learned that there is no limit to God's creativity, love, and ability to bring good out of even the most tragic of circumstances. I am also humbled to know and work with many dedicated volunteers who give great service to the Church and their communities. For me this is the church at its very best!"

Prior to her parish work in Connellsville, Sister Donna ministered as a teacher, hospital chaplain, campus minister and pastoral associate at Pennsylvania sites that include Greensburg Catholic Middle School, Greensburg; Kane Regional Center, Glen Hazel; Saints Simon and Jude Parish, Blairsville; Seton Hill University, Greensburg; and Our Lady of the Assumption Parish located in Coral, and Lucernmines.

Before she entered the Sisters of Charity, Sister Donna taught for 12 years in the catholic schools of the Altoona-Johnstown Diocese (Saint Mark, Altoona, and Saint Michael, Loretto). She was also involved in faith formation as a catechist for 12 years at the parishes of Saint Nicholas (Nicktown), Saint Mark (Altoona), and Saint Michael (Loretto). Sister Donna is a graduate of Bishop Carroll High School and holds a bachelor of science degree in secondary mathematics and education from Penn State University, a master of education degree in reading from Indiana University of Pennsylvania, and a master of arts degree in theology from Washington Theological Union, Washington, DC.

In reflecting on the charism of the Sisters of Charity and the celebration of 25 years of religious life, Sister Donna conveyed, "Two facets of our community life have been especially important to me: love for the Eucharist and our commitment to the poor, especially women and children. Both of these are at the heart of our life, mission and ministry. We draw strength from the Eucharist to serve those in need and then bring those concerns back to table of the Lord. It is both of these taken together that give my life its meaning and purpose!"



Donor Report – A Divine



The portrait of Saint Elizabeth Ann Seton on the cover of this program was painted by Sister M. Fides Glass, SC (1989-1955). Sister Fides was widely known author, artist, and teacher of art. She ministered as an art supervisor in the Catholic schools staffed by the Sisters of Charity. She also taught art at Saint Joseph Academy at Seton Hill and at Seton Hill College (both precursors to Seton Hill University). In 1934, Sister M. Fides visited Emmitsburg, Maryland, and drew a variety of crayon sketches of the grounds and buildings where Mother Seton lived and walked. The details from those sketches are incorporated into this 1948 portrait that includes Mother Seton's Stone House in the background. This portrait of Mother Seton is probably the most recognized piece in the body of work that Sister Fides produced.

One morning in 1808, an excited Elizabeth Ann Seton visited her spiritual director. She told him that she had heard the “clear and intelligible voice” of the Lord speak to her during Mass. She had been praying for financial help for the creation of a Catholic school for women. The Lord told her to approach “Mr. Cooper,” a wealthy convert from Philadelphia, for money to create the school. That very evening, Mr. Samuel Sutherland Cooper visited the same spiritual director and offered to give \$10,000 for the establishment of a Catholic school for young women. The spiritual director was amazed for Mr. Cooper had no prior discussions with Elizabeth concerning the school and certainly knew nothing of the voice she had heard.

This divine moment was the beginning of the strong bond between the Sisters of Charity and their lay friends, a bond that still exists today.

We value our close relationship with our lay friends who provide a strong support for the ministries of the Sisters of Charity. Many of our friends are volunteers. Many more provide financial gifts that help us to pay the bills. Some even make provisions in their wills in order to ensure continual support for God's work. All of our friends are dear to us and we pray for them daily.

Our donor list is divided into the following four giving categories:

The Friends of Charity

The Friends of Charity represent our largest group of donors. With annual gifts between \$1 and \$299, they collectively make a huge impact in the support of our ministries. Every donation is received with thanksgiving and prayer on the donor's behalf.

The Circle of Charity

The "Stone House" in Emmitsburg, Maryland, pictured in this 1934 sketch by Sister M. Fides, stands today as it did in the time of Mother Seton. It is often referred to as the cradle of the community. Mother Seton first came to it on July 31, 1809. Within its walls, the first Mass in the valley was said on August 10, 1809. The garret of the house served as a dormitory for the sisters. Ownership of the Stone House was made possible by the generosity of the first "Partner" of the Sisters of Charity, Samuel Sutherland Cooper.

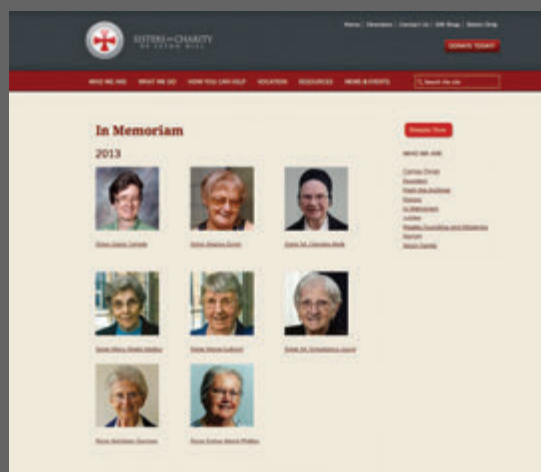
